#### STEPS

- 1. Check the laryngoscope light before use.
- 2. To turn on the light, pull and completely remove the tab from the handle.
- 3. Use the right paraglossal approach to insert the blade and lift the laryngoscope handle by the hook to facilitate display of the larynx for intubation.
- 4. Dispose of Yeescope<sup>™</sup> and batteries after use in accordance with hospital policy.

#### **BATTERY REMOVAL**

- Using the red spanner provided in the box, attach the spanner over the hook on the end cap of the Yeescope<sup>™</sup> handle.
- Once the spanner is securely in position; using one hand hold the blade of the Yeescope<sup>™</sup> firmly and with your other hand turn the spanner to unlock the end cap.
- 3. Remove end cap to release the batteries from the battery compartment. Dispose of the batteries as per facility protocol.
- 4. Dispose of the Yeescope  ${}^{\scriptscriptstyle \mathrm{M}}$  as per Facility protocol.
