# instruction for use

## **DESCRIPTION**

m|devices star lumen Oxygen Tubing design features a channeled inner lumen to resist kinks and occlusion, for the delivery of oxygen to the patient.

The tubing is attached to either a face mask, nasal cannula or nebuliser set.

Available in 4 different lengths; 2.1m, 3m, 4m and 30m.

Optional stepped connector for the 3m length AN135001NS.

### **STEPS**

- 1. Remove the product from the packaging.
- 2. Attach the Oxygen Tubing to the oxygen source and set to the prescribed flow.
- 3. Check for oxygen flow through the tubing.
- 4. Attach to desired mask, nasal cannula or nebuliser, ensuring that all connections are secured.



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
