

# UR040000 - UR042006 Nelaton Catheters

## instruction for use

#### **DESCRIPTION**

m|devices Nelaton Catheters are available in a variety of lengths;

- Paediatric 30cm
- Female 20cm
- Male 40cm

Intended for intermittent bladder catheterisation. These catheters offer a perfectly finished closed distal end for smooth insertion. The bilateral eyelets allow for efficient drainage and have a funnel shaped colour coded connector at the proximal end.

FOR USE BY AN ADEQUATELY TRAINED USER. THE BELOW IS ONLY A SUGGESTION AND THE USER SHOULD BE THOROUGHLY EDUCATED PRIOR TO ATTEMPTING TO SELF CATHETERISE AND BE AWARE OF INFECTION CONTROL PRINCIPLES.

## **A**CAUTION

- Single Use
- DO NOT use if packaging or product has been damaged or contaminated.
- DO NOT store at extreme temperatures and humidity, avoid direct sunlight

#### **STEPS**

- Peel package open maintaining sterility and add sterile water-based lubricant 2.5cm from the distal tip.
- 2. Remove catheter from package taking care not to contaminate.
- Insert the now lubricated catheter gently into the urethra passage until urine starts to flow.
   Urine can be drained into toilet or into a urine drainage bag connected to the catheters funnel.
- 4. When bladder is empty, slowly remove the catheter and place the used catheter into empty package for disposal.

### **PRECAUTIONS**

 Maintaining aseptic technique during insertionis crucial. If the catheter becomes contaminated, discard and commence procedure using a new catheter.
