Drainage Bags

i INSTRUCTION FOR USE

DESCRIPTION

Intended Use: m|devices urine drainage bags without outlet are designed for the drainage of urine or other bodily fluids. Clear incremental markings provide precise volumes of drainage.

THE BELOW IS ONLY A SUGGESTION AND FACILITY PROTOCOL MUST BE FOLLOWED FOR ALL CLINICAL PROCEDURES WHERE THIS PRODUCT IS USED.

▲ CAUTION Single patient use DO NOT re-sterilise DO NOT use if packaging or product has been damaged or contaminated. DO NOT store at extreme temperatures and humidity, avoid direct sunlight.

STEPS:

- 1. Perform hand hygiene.
- 2. Remove bag from the packaging.
- Using aseptic technique, remove cap from the drainage tubing and connect directly into the funnel of the urinary catheter.
- 4. Ensure the connection is secure.
- 5. Hang the bag at or below the patient's bladder level.
- 6. Once bag is full, perform hand hygiene and don gloves.
- Maintaining aseptic technique, disconnect the drainage bag from the urinary catheter and dispose of as per facility protocol.
- 8. Repeat the above procedure if reconnecting a new drainage bag.

PRECAUTIONS:

- Ensure the drainage bag is never raised higher than the level of the bladder
- Ensure the drainage bag tubing is free from kinks at all times when connected to the catheter
- Ensure aseptic technique is maintained when handling connecting and disconnecting the drainage bag from the urinary catheter.

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
