STEPS

- 1. Perform hand hygiene.
- 2. Remove bag from the packaging.
- 3. Using aseptic technique, remove cap from the drainage tubing and connect directly into the funnel of the urinary catheter.
- 4. Ensure the connection is secure.
- 5. Hang the bag at or below the patient's bladder level.
- 6. Once bag is full, perform hand hygiene and don gloves.
- 7. Maintaining aseptic technique, disconnect the drainage bag from the urinary catheter and dispose of as per facility
- 8. Repeat the above procedure if reconnecting a new Urine Bag.

PRECAUTIONS

- Ensure the Urine Bag is never raised higher than the level of the bladder
- Ensure the Urine Bag tubing is free from kinks at all times when connected to the catheter
- · Ensure aseptic technique is maintained when handling, connecting and disconnecting the Urine Bag from the urinary catheter
